#### 12. Intersection of Meadow View Lane and Green View Lane – Citizens(s) safety concerns

- Josh Roberts came to the Town Hall with safety concerns for stop sign concerns
- Town of Hull Roads collected statistics from 09.05.2023 until 09.11.2023 for Meadow View Lane and Greenview Lane to see the average daily count, speed and other data.
- Longtime resident Kathleen Martinsen for many years now has witnessed the growing dangers of this intersection. This area has kids that wait for the bus along with walkers and other children that play outside. People driving in this area are not slowing down. Many drivers in area do not stop or slow down at all at this intersection. It is important to get some kind of enforcement to make sure that people stop at stop sign. Branches on corner should be cut to ensure that all ways are safely visible.
- Neighbors would like the Town of Hull Board to send letter to all in area to warn them of this danger and the consequences for not following the law. Another thought is to put in speed bumps to make drivers slow down.

- Corner lot resident M. Zblewski -Seems to be worse on weekends. No one is even slowing down to go around curve.
- J. Roberts ask the board when is it enough, when someone's kid gets hurt. Do we have to come back here in 5 years with the same problem that is still an issue? Tired of trying to get results from the Town.
- Six residents total here that all live on the corner area all voicing concerns for this intersection. Coming from town going to Meadow view you cannot even see properly due to branches in way.
- Road Foreman ask about how many people actually stop or just completely blow through that stop sign, residents say both are a problem. Seems to be the same people.
- Board assures residents that safety is a top priority.
- Already a three way stop with upcoming warning signs all know is a danger and still a problem.
- 7-9am and 4-6pm seems to be the worst times.
- Road Foremen discusses with residents possible solutions to this problem.
- Enforcement will be reached out to Portage County Sheriff within the next 24 hours. Letter out to residents.
