Announcement – Address Numbers

Over the past several years, the Town of Hull has been encouraged to begin utilizing an “Address Numbering” system as a universal way to mark addresses on citizens’ properties that contain homes or buildings. Simply stated, citizen addresses are put on a small metal sign and then this numbered sign is anchored by way of a metal stake adjacent to the homeowner’s driveway.

The Portage County Sheriff’s Department, the Portage County Ambulance Service, The Town of Hull Fire Department, the Town of Hull Emergency Services Department and other communities that provide mutual aid to the Town of Hull, have strongly encouraged us to go with this system. The Town of Hull is one of the only towns in Portage County that does not currently participate in this addressing system. It has become the standard choice not only in Portage County but across other communities in the state for most towns and some villages.

The address number system concept was strongly encouraged by Hull citizens at last year’s Annual Meeting. The implementation study and phase in will be in 2025. Early next year, the Town will send out specific information about the need and the implementation of the program. There will be public meeting opportunities to allow citizens to become familiar with the program and ask questions or voice their concerns.

There will be no cost to citizens for the implementation of this program. The Town will designate ARPA funds from the Federal Government to pay for the implementation costs.
