If you have a dog 5 months or over, a license is required by WI State Law, on **or before MARCH 31, 2024**  
**\$5.00 LATE FEE** *must be charged* for any license purchased after March 31, 2024.

A license CAN NOT be issued without the **CERTIFICATION OF RABIES RECEIPT** (or copy).  
All owners must present evidence that the dog was neutered or spayed to qualify for the lower license fee.

To All Dog Owners in Portage County:

State law and Portage County ordinances **require all dogs to be licensed**, and that rabies vaccinations be current. The owner of any dog more than 5 months of age on January 1—or within the license year—must obtain a license for that dog. A dog license is valid from January 1 to December 31. There is a mandatory late fee if you fail to obtain a license by April 1 or after 30 days of ownership of a new, unlicensed dog.

Dog licenses can be easily obtained from your municipal treasurer or the Humane Society of Portage County, and they are reasonably priced. Owners of kennels or those with many dogs can also obtain a multiple dog license. **The citation for owners of unlicensed dogs costs between \$169.00 and \$263.50.**
