RE: Onsite visit to roads on Wednesday, June 29, 2011

At the Hull Town Board meeting on June 6<sup>th</sup> the Board agreed they would conduct an onsite visit to Granite Ridge Road, Driftwood Drive, Ann Marie Court and Airport Road. The purpose of these visits is to look at drainage problems in anticipation of doing additional road work at those sites. The Board has agreed the onsite would take place on Wednesday, June 29<sup>th</sup> with a Board meeting at the town municipal hall at 4:30pm. Below is an outline of the schedule in order for citizens to be in attendance as we arrive onsite. We will also on this tour look at several potential dry hydrant sites for the Hull Fire Department. The schedule would be as follows:

4:30pm	Hull Board and Gremmer Engineering meet at Hull Municipal Building
4:45pm	Visit the Dry Hydrant site near the Red Bridge on Walkush Rd.
5:00pm	Visit Granite Ridge Road and Driftwood Drive (initial stop at the intersection of Pine Bluff Road and Granite Ridge Road.
5:40pm	Visit potential site of a dry hydrant on Scenic Drive near Hwy. X.
6:00pm	Visit Ann Marie Court off of Jordan Road to look at a cul-de-sac.
6:30pm	Visit Airport Road to look at drainage problems on parts of roadway.

The above is an approximate schedule of when we would be at the various sites. Those who receive this notice should advise their neighbors of the times the Town Board will be in their neighborhood.

Attending the onsite with the Hull Town Board will be a representative from Gremmer and Associates Engineering. The Board will reconvene at the Town Municipal Building at approximately 7:00pm for a short meeting and discuss the results of the onsite. They will direct Gremmer engineering to conduct a more intense evaluation of drainage problems and develop a road reconstruction plan where needed.

Once Gremmer Engineering has developed a design plan for each site the Town Board will meet and invite citizens and households impacted to attend prior to Hull Board approval to go ahead with any drainage/road work. That meeting will probably be held in late July or early August. The hope is to complete road work by September or October at the latest.
