Discussion:

- Negotiation documents with city of Stevens Point relating to in particular the use of Well #11
- Claims made by citizens impacted to date handled separately by a different attorney
- Impact created by Well #11 what do we do going forward?
- Create a process where residents with well impacted by the city when they modify their usage, will be able to access a reimbursement process
- Citizens with wells impacted will provide written or electronic notification to the city within 5 working days
- High capacity non-residential wells ineligible
- Reimbursement for well replacement of sand point or drilled wells
- Health standards have to be met relating to well water, does not include aesthetic minerals
- Need to talk about quality of water
- Create objective standards
- Monitoring by city →create strong data base of what happening to water table
- Measure water usage by city →public record. Will know pattern of changes in well/what happening to water quantity (level)
- Burden of proof shall be on the city
- City will provide Hull with data from hew monitoring wells (semiannually)
- Add paragraph well guarantee in event the city plans or expects to exceed average pumping rate it shall notify the town
- Provide citizens with notice → information sheet explaining alternative process, what they have to do, what assistance is available. Post on web site; posting board; direct mail (1 page info sheet on colored paper)
- City pub engineering company and insurance company on notice as well down gradient from many individual wells
- Pay your own way for lawyers & litigation experts unless statute give authority to receive payback of attorney fees
