10. History of Levy Limits

- Dave Wilz educates on upcoming Budgets
- What is a Levy? Levy comes directly from tax payers. Every month you receive a Statement of Revenue, General property taxes, Levy is coming from the tax payers
 - 2005 State was involved in Levy Limits, Can only raise Levy by 3%, Borrowing-separate
 - 2011 Governor's Budget Repair Bill-Act 10: No increase to Levy at all, Debt is allowed and can raise the Levy to cover
 - Operational Rate=Mill Rate
 - Revaluation affects Levy
 - Debt Service rate-buying equipment, Roads
 - Referendum is needed for Levy increase for population of 3,000 or more citizens
 - Explanation of Governor's Repair Bill
 - Shared Revenues=Money back from state

- Involves 3 Loans, restructure TOH debt
- Approved purchase of Fire Truck, and Loader which has been put on hold
