- ➤ Hull citizen complaint about the continued issues of 527 Maple Bluff Rd, this was addressed with the Board, fence put up, Town of Hull meeting decision was made that property was up to code, now extending to front of house, 25' to road, rat issues, fire issue, \$27,000 in legal fees spent by Hull with no results, operating a illegal business? (Salvage yard)
- > Hull citizen comments building permit needed but this resident can do this? Who wants to live next to this? Pictures available, hire a lawyer,
- > Hull citizen owns two residents in this neighborhood and is frustrated
- Hull citizen witnessed him with material and passing it off to someone else, this is not zoned for business, legal action, devaluating our property, we want to be represented by the Board
- > Hull citizen new to area and is living next to this is upset that there isn't like HOA's to protect owners, nothing stopping him
- > John Holdridge suggests hiring another attorney
- > Barb Brilowski states incident with the Fire dept and citizens
