

ORDINANCE NO. 2004-0503 - 2
NO PARKING
WALKUSH ROAD

No Parking zones are hereby established on Walkush Road.

The reason for the No Parking zones are to accommodate fisherpersons (both winter and summer), duck hunters and others who park vehicles along the roadway with the needs of Hull snowplowing, school buses, Fire Department vehicles, ambulances and other vehicles to ensure safe passage along the road.

Specifically, Parking shall be prohibited on the north side of Walkush Road just below the hill off of Casimir Road going west to the Red Bridge (approximately 2/10 of a mile). Marked by no parking signs.

The No Parking zone will continue from Red Bridge west on the north side of the road for approximately 3/10 of a mile. Marked by no parking signs.

Furthermore, a No Parking zone will be established on both sides of the road where water on both sides of the road narrows the shoulders on Walkush Road. Two such zones will be created and marked.

In addition, parking will be prohibited in the boat launching area with a sign so indicating.


Persons violating this Ordinance will be subject to a forfeiture of \$20.00, plus court costs and the cost of prosecution for the first offense and a forfeiture of \$50.00, plus court costs and the cost of prosecution for any second or subsequent violation within one year of the first violation. Each and every day of a violation shall constitute a separate offense. Citations may be issued by any Portage County Sheriff's Department officer.

No Parking signs will be erected upon passage and publication of the ordinance.

The ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as required by law.
